STANDING ORDER 21: DETERMINATION BY THE FIRST MINISTER (DESIGNATE) AND THE DEPUTY FIRST MINISTER (DESIGNATE)

In accordance with Standing Order 21 of the Initial Standing Orders of the New Northern Ireland Assembly, we hereby determine:

- a. that there shall be ten Ministerial offices as set out in column 1 of the Table below; and
- b. that the holder of each such office shall, as from the day appointed under section 3(1) of the Northern Ireland Act 1998, be in charge of the Northern Ireland Department specified in relation to that office in column 2 of the Table and shall exercise the functions of Minister of that Department.
