TAOISEACH'S MEETING WITH THE BRITISH PRIME MINISTER FRIDAY, 3 DECEMBER, 1993.

- 9.15 a.m. A briefing for the Irish delegation will take place in Dublin Castle (Kings Bedroom) see attached map.
- 10.40 a.m. (approx) The British delegation, including the Prime
 Minister, Sir Patrick Mayhew, Secretary of
 State for Northern Ireland and Douglas Hurd,
 Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth
 Affairs will arrive by RAF aircraft at
 Baldonnel.
 - On arrival the Prime Minister will be greeted by the British Ambassador and by the Chief of Protocol, Department of Foreign Affairs, Mr. John Burke, both of whom will accompany the British delegation by RAF helicopter to Dublin Castle.
- 10.55 a.m. (approx) The helicopters will arrive at the rear of Dublin Castle.
 - On arrival the Prime Minister and his party will be greeted by Brian McCarthy, Assistant Secretary to the Government and directed to waiting cars for transportation to the main entrance to the State Apartments.
- 11.00 a.m. On arrival at the main entrance to the State
 Apartments, the Prime Minister, and his party,
 will be greeted by the Taoiseach, Tánaiste and
 Minister for Justice. This will be a
 photocall.
 - Back-up staff travelling with the Prime Minister will enter the State Apartments by another door.
 - The Taoiseach, Tánaiste, and Minister for Justice will escort the Prime Minister and his party to the Throne Room for introductions to other members of the Irish delegation and for refreshments.

11.10 a.m. to 11.25 a.m.

- The Taoiseach, accompanied by both the Tánaiste and Minister for Justice, and the Prime Minister, accompanied by both Secretaries of State, will be escorted to the Apollo Room (see the attached map) for a meeting. This will be a photo opportunity and will be televised by RTE on a pooled basis.
- The Tánaiste and Minister for Justice will withdraw, along with the Secretaries of State, to the Kings Bedroom for a separate meeting which will cover Security, GATT, EU and other issues (see attached list-A).
- The Taoiseach and the Prime Minister will have a short teté-a-teté <u>before</u> being joined by Dr. Martin Mansergh and by Rod Lyne.
- 12.45 p.m. (approx) -

The Taoiseach and Prime Minister will have lunch with certain members of the delegations (see attached list-B) in the Drawing Room (see attached map). This lunch will be preceded by a drinks reception. Other members of the delegations will dine in the Throne Room.


2.00 p.m. (approx) -

The Drawing Room group will adjourn to the Kings Bedroom to continue talks.




