TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH JOHN HUME

John Hume phoned PUS on 11 November. He wanted to know whether HMG were totally opposed to any advance on the peace front; PUS confirmed that the points that Mr Hume had made to the Prime Minister about the opportunity that existed for an initiative to work and the prize to be claimed were well understood and were certainly not being ignored. Although PUS gave no indication that anything more would be coming from HMG, Mr Hume seemed to be expecting it, but was not pressing hard for rapid movement. He telephoned again today from Strasbourg, and hopes to speak to PUS tonight.
