HANDLING PLAN

This handling plan assumes that we have agreed the text of a Joint Declaration with the Irish Government (probably in Brussels) and that the Prime Minister and the Taoiseach will wish to make a public statement very soon afterwards - probably in London on rangements for Summit (So. 10, PCO, NEO); and 16 December.

The plan deals with those steps which will be needed before and immediately following the making of the Joint Declaration. (d) British/Irish officials coordinate drafts of

Timetable

- at lines to take and Q and A material. Ministerial meeting considers JD15 text.
- If text approved (subject to amendments), Cabinet invited to give general authority for the proposed 2. course of action.
- As soon as practicable afterwards: 3.
 - MA Washington (FCO), NIO Ministerial (a) Prime Minister to see Mr Molyneaux to show him text and seek his general acquiescence;
 - SofSNI to arrange to see Mr Hume ?before (b) Brussels.
- Joint Declaration text agreed in Brussels.

[Irish Government will probably seek to ascertain reaction in wider nationalist community and gauge prospects for a cessation of violence.]

5. As soon as possible after Brussels:

- (a) briefings for RUC Chief Constable and GOC(NI)
 (NIO), Buckingham Palace (Cabinet Secretary),
 President Clinton (PM by telephone);
- (b) arrangements for Summit (No.10, FCO, NIO); and Press Conference (No.10);
- (c) Prime Minister to minute Cabinet;
- (d) British/Irish officials coordinate drafts of joint lines to take and Q and A material.

6. 24 hours before Joint Declaration:

- (a) briefings for Leader of the Opposition and Mr Ashdown (PM);
- (b) Mr Molyneaux, Mr Hume and Dr Alderdice (NIO),
 HMA Washington (FCO), NIO Ministerial team
 (NIO) told of arrangements for Joint
 Declaration, Press Conference etc;
- (c) media told of QE2 Press Conference (No.10).
- Taoiseach and Prime Minister meet for Summit and formally agree Joint Declaration.
- 8. Public statement made by Prime Minister (supported by senior colleagues? ie Foreign Secretary, SofSNI), and Taoiseach at Press Conference, followed by Q and A session.

- Just before Immediately following public statement: follow-up briefings for key journalists (No.10 and NIO), opinion formers and community leaders in Northern Ireland (NIO), key politicians on Capitol Hill (HMA Washington); guidance telegram to Posts (FCO).
 - Following day (Friday 17 December?) Prime Minister makes Statement in the House [briefings (with text) 10. necessary for Opposition spokespeople on Northern Ireland in Commons and Lords, and Northern Ireland party leaders (No.10)]
 - ?After cessation of violence: Irish Government announce unilaterally establishment of Permanent [11. Irish Convention.]
