## I attach below the following:

- ii. A draft Parliamentary statement. This includes extensive direct quotes from the Joint Declaration. Do you agree this is appropriate for the occasion.
- iii. A draft of the broadcast. This is a lightly edited version of what you dictated earlier this evening. Subject to any further comments you have at this stage, we will get the wordsmiths to work on it during the day.
- iv. A draft opening statement for the press conference.

- v. A note on who is briefing whom.
