1. The Chairman brought the session to order at 10.10 saying that four representatives had sought recognition.

2. The UUP inquired if British and Irish Government Ministers would be attending. The session was informed by the British and Irish Governments that Ministers would be attending shortly. The UKUP, expressing no reflection upon the civil servants present, said it preferred the political representatives of both governments to be present, and proposed that there be an adjournment until Ministers were present. The Chairman asked for views on that proposal. The UUP said that there was no point in proceeding in the absence of the political representatives. The DUP said that it wished to address questions to Ministers.
