RESPONSE TO CHAIRMAN ON HOW TO PROGRESS

- 1. Under Paragraph 5 of the Rules of Procedure the Chairman should establish two Sub-committees of the Plenary as follows;
 - Sub-committee 1 to explore arrangements and relationships "in the round"
 - Sub-committee 2 to explore justice and rights issues "in the round"
- These Sub-committees should be chaired by the Plenary Chairman and his alternate.
- 3. The Sub-committee should be comprised of two persons per participant with one backup person.
- 4. The remit of the Sub-committees should be to explore and discuss " in the round" with no commitment being required from participants for agreement. This should not rule out the possibility for agreement, if agreement is forthcoming.
- 5. The sub-committee Chairman should take the soundings of the Sub-committee as to general agreement and identify areas of disagreement. Areas of agreement and disagreement should be checked with each party subsequently.
- 6. These Sub-committees could meet for three days in the first instance, with appropriate breaks for bilaterals if required.
- Subsequently the Sub-committee could meet on Monday and Tuesday mornings with the afternoon of each day devoted to meetings in Strand 1 and Strand 2 format for more detailed discussion.
