RESPONSE ON PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. Each participant has an unfettered right to table motions.
- 2. All participants have the right to have their motions debated and voted on provided their motion relates to the current agenda item.
- The timing and sequence for taking motions should be set by the Business Committee.
- 4. The Business Committee may impose a limitation on the time for debate.
- 5. Any limitation on debate will be dependent on (1) the number of motions to be determined, (2) the overall programme of business and (3) the nature of the motion.
- 6. If a motion is not relevant to the matter then pending, the Business Committee must provide an indicative time frame within which the motion will be taken. [Such a time frame will be influenced by the substance of the motion.]
- 7. Each participant has an unfettered right to table amendments.
- 8. The first amendment tabled should be taken first.
