ALLIANCE PARTY INITIAL COMMENTS ON DRAFT PAPER FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF STRAND ONE

- Para 1. To facilitate the representation of smaller parties, the Assembly should have 108 seats with 6 members elected by PR/STV from each of the 18 parliamentary constituencies.
- Para 2. The functions devolved should cover **AT LEAST** the responsibilities of the six current **NI** departments.
- Para 3(iv). Members would have to formally identify themselves as Unionist, Nationalist, or Non-Aligned in order to satisfy the requirements of this sub-paragraph.
- Para 5.

 a. This model does not give sufficient strategic, policy and budgetary direction as would be possible in a cabinet-style model. Necessary changes would include freeing the Chair and Deputy Chair of Departmental responsibilities to enable them to concentrate on coordination and leadership.
 - b. We believe that Justice should be a devolved Department and, therefore, would have a Departmental (not non-Departmental) Committee.
- Para 9(vi). It may be necessary to have procedures to remove not only a post-holder but a whole party from office in certain extraordinary circumstances.
