SDLP and UUP agree:

- 1. The D'Hondt system will be used for allocation of posts.
- 2. There will be Secretaries/Ministers/Departmental Heads.
- 3. There will be a First Minister/Secretary and a Second Minister/ Secretary

(NOT AGREED)

- 4. There will be Committees of the Assembly.
- 5. There will be Chairmen of Assembly Committees.
- 6. The Chairmen of Assembly Committees will be appointed on the D'Hondt system.
- 7. There will be arrangements for the Ministers/Secretaries/Heads of Departments to meet together.
- 8. The Assembly Committees will have a scrutinising and policy development role.
- 9. One of the roles of a Minister/Secretary is to be head of a Department.
- 10. The Assembly will have a legislative role.
- Legislation can be initiated by an individual, a Committee or a Minister/Secretary/Head of Department.
- 12. The Assembly will be operated on a European Parliament style timetabling model.
- 13. Attendance at outside bodies e.g. North/South Council and Council of the Isles will be on the basis of sufficient inclusion.
