Implementation Bodies

An implementation body is a structure with the design and remit to implement decisions agreed and ratified by respective parliaments North and South or by agreement of mandated ministers at the North/South Council.

Decisions should be implemented separately in each jurisdiction, making the implementation body more accountable to their own parliament.

We see no reason as to why implementation bodies, North and South, could not consult on mechanisms of, and progress on, implementation.

The make-up and size of implementation bodies should be such that it reflects the expertise and human resources required in carrying out its remit.

In Northern Ireland, appointment to such bodies would come from within the Northern Ireland Civil Service and any relevant department. These appointments would be made by the committee responsible for that particular area of government.
