Principles and requirements

- 1. The constitutional status of Northern Ireland as an integral part of the United Kingdom should be recognised.
- 2. The right to self-determination of the people of Northern Ireland is inviolate.
- 3. A commitment to purely democratic means is required.
- 4. Any relationship between Northern Ireland and the Irish Republic must be on an entirely voluntary basis and operate in the context of broader co-operation between and amongst the various regions of the British Isles.
- 5. Articles 2 and 3 of the Irish Constitution should be rescinded.
- 6. Economic and security co-operation should be discussed within the broader context of the British Isles and the European Union.
- 7. The Anglo-Irish Agreement will be superseded by any new arrangement.
- 8. The principle of consent is paramount.
