
- delegations advised to arrive during the morning; buffet lunch ?Secretary of State meets Mr Trimble. ?meetings with other Unionist parties

- formal declarations by each delegation making clear their total and absolute commitment to the International Body's principles of democracy and non-violence (?the two Governments, followed by the parties in alphabetical order ie clockwise)
- secure agreement to a <u>public statement</u> capturing those commitments in unambiguous language (draft to be offered to Senator Mitchell)
 - <u>? Senator Mitchell to read statement to media</u> at close of business
- appointment of Business Committee (? 2 per Government/larger
 party, 1 from each of the 4 smaller parties)
- NB probably UUP objections to the rest of the agenda (? remit to Business Committee initially, or take as point of order)
- if appropriate, begin round of opening statements (? order, as before)
- concluding the day's business
 - agree format/time for next meeting
 - <u>agree terms of any statement to the press</u> (including statement recording everyone's total and absolute commitment to the International Body's principles)
