- This is to let you have a minor, but relatively important correction to your note of yesterday's pre-plenary meeting.
- 2. In paragraph 25, the final passage of the last sentence ("but the Secretary of State refused this") should in fact come at the end of the penultimate sentence ("Dr Paisley suggested a further one hour adjournment ...").
