Unfortunately, it has become clear since the earlier advice was provided that a further connection had been put in place, to the Stormont Castle press office.
- With the Prime Ministers' visit over and the Independent 3. Chairmen in the chamber, there would be less inconvenience now in discontinuing the feeds; and doing so might help allay suspicions among delegations, and permit us more readily to assert that the talks are meant to be confidential. It was in fact arranged for them to be taken out of use last night (before the independent Chairman took over). If the Secretary of State agrees they should remain disconnected, he may wish to write to Dr Paisley and other delegation heads.
