PROPOSAL

That the Ulster Unionist Party is prepared to accept the proposals relating to the Chairmanship of Negotiations, contained in the 6 June 1996 Paper sent to the Party Leader by Secretary of State Mayhew, with the single proviso that the rules pertaining to Chairmanships should be, in appropriately adapted form, those which pertained during the Strand 2 element of the 1992 Talks.
as originally proposed agreed by Unionist Party & SDLP.

The Ulster Unionist Party proposes that the said 1992 rules, in the form tendered, should be accepted pro tem, until such time as a committee of plenary to consider Procedural Guidelines (Govt Paper dated 11 June, para 5) is able to report and that George Mitchell be now requested to assume the Chair and to proceed with the business as outlined in the June 11 Paper.
