LABOUR DELEGATION AT THE ALL-PARTY SUBSTANTIVE TALKS

I have just heard to-day from Hugh Casey that he has received a letter from you in which you indicate that you have written to the Secretary of State informing him that you have removed me as Head of the Labour Delegation to the All-Party Substantive Talks.
