- Grateful for your contribution to <u>talks</u>. Share your frustration about lack of progress.
- Determined to jolt process into life this week. Mitchell shares this view.
- Decommissioning: our approach based on Mitchell. Cannot be ducked.
 But accept it has to be <u>mutual</u>.
- <u>Punishment beatings</u>: wrong and contrary to Mitchell principles. Please use influence to stop. Weakens loyalist cause.
- <u>Marches, etc</u>: confrontation and intimidation play into IRA's hands.

 Ideas for the future? Apprentice Boys?
- Prisoners: aware of your strong concern. Number of improvements since the ceasefire. Obviously cannot discriminate between Republican and Loyalist prisoners.
- Sir P. Mayhew ready to consider your ideas for improvements when he has them.
