Born in July 1953, Ervine is married with two children. Educated at Orangefield Boys Secondary School in East Belfast, Ervine was sentenced to 11 years imprisonment for possession of explosives in 1974. He was released in 1980. In 1994, Ervine came to prominence as a spokesman for the PUP enunciating their position and setting out a socialist unionist agenda.

Highly articulate and skilled at presenting the PUP's position as reasonable and pragmatic, Ervine clearly enjoys the spotlight. Rumours surface from time to time of his pronouncements earning the disapproval of Loyalist leaders suspicious of Ervine representing their interests with less enthusiasm than his own.
