REPLY.

The position on this matter remains as set out in reply to Dáil Questions on 25 June.

I said on that occasion that the two questions posed to Sinn Féin by the Government on 18 June flow directly from the Mitchell Six Principles and that they are questions which Sinn Féin will have to face once they enter the multi-party talks. That party's participation in those talks is conditional on a restoration of the IRA ceasefire and to that end, the Government are keeping open lines of communication with Sinn Féin.
