LONDONDERRY AND SINN FEIN

The Party Chairman spoke to me this morning to pass on some information from 'a friend'. It may well duplicate information you already have but he asked me to pass it on. This I do.

His friend with contacts in Sinn Fein told him last night that since Sinn Fein had decided the Government was going to lose the election and so would do all it can to embarrass the Government in the meantime. To this end, Sinn Fein intended to maximise the trouble including violence on the streets of Londonderry over the weekend.
