NORTHERN IRELAND GRAND COMMITTEE

As you know, the meeting with the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland which was scheduled to take place this morning had to be cancelled because of the length of Cabinet. However, the Lord President informed me that, in the margins of Cabinet, he and the Chief Whip spoke to Sir Patrick Mayhew and agreed that Sir Patrick should proceed with his consultation on the lines set out in his minute to the Lord President of 20 December 1996. Consequently, no further meeting is needed for the time being.
