Amnesty International is concerned that the conditions of detantion in which Rossin McAliskey is being held may amount to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment.

Roisin McAliskey was errested on 20 November 1996 in Northern Ireland. Shewas detained under emergency lews and interrogated for six days in Castlereigh holding centre. On 27 November the was remanded in custody in London on the besis of an extradition warrant issued by the German authorities in connection with an Irish Republican Army mortar attack on the British army base in Osnabruck, Germany, in June 1996. On 31 November the was transferred to Belmarsh Prison, a men's prison. However, on 5 December, in response to worldwide protests, Roisin McAliskey was transferred back to Holloway Prison, a women's prison in London.

When errested, Rolsin McAliskey was about four months pregnant and suffering from various medical silments, including asthma, an eating disorder and severe underweight. It was reported that because she was not receiving adequate medical attention, there was a danger to the continuation of the pregnancy. Rolain McAliskey is currently about six to seven months pregnant. The conditions of detention have led to a deterioration in her physical and psychological health, and give cause for concern.

As a Catagory A high-security risk prisoner on remand, Roisin McAliskey is strip-secretical twice a day, morning and evening, as well as before and after visits even though shares. "Cipied Visits, meaning that there is no possible physical content between her and her visitor. Administry international is concerned that this regular strip-searching, canacially in nonnegative with her visits. may not be recessary for security purposes and may lead to cruel, inhuman or degrating rectinent. She is also reportedly restricted to taking her exercises on the roof of the prison.

Questions have also been relead about the conditions in which she will give birth and whether she will be allowed to remain with her body. It has been reported that because this to what angithy A prisoner, she would not be able to avail herself of the facilities in the mother and tably unit at Holloway Prison, unless it was not being used by other prisoners. In Amnesty Interribitingly view the cutcome of this possible decision to separate mother and haby would amount to cruel, intuman or degrading treatment and would damage permanently the mother-child bonding relationship. It is also taknown whether, if she was extradited to Germany, she would be able to keep the baby with her?
