Congratulations on your outstanding electoral success. Good luck to you in your new position, and in your efforts to implement the priorities you have set for yourself and your government.

I am certain that these will include the issue of a lasting peace in Ireland. Be assured that this is a priority for me also and that Sinn Fein is totally committed to democratic and peaceful methods of struggle and to a negotiated settlement to the conflict in our country.

The rebuilding of a credible peace process must be tackled without further delay. I would request, therefore, that you authorise officials of your government to meet with Sinn Fein as soon as possible so that we can explore with urgency how this can be accomplished.

While I am mindful of the difficulties for all concerned I remain confident that the peace process can be established on a solid basis of equality and inclusive dialogue.

That certainly is my commitment.
