The two Governments see the resolution of the decommissioning issue as an indispensable part of the process of negotiation, alongside other confidence-building measures for all sides. They recognise that decommissioning should not become a blockage in the talks. The two Governments are determined to achieve through all-party negotiations on a comprehensive and substantive agenda the complete and permanent decommissioning of all illegally-held paramilitary weapons and look to all parties, in good faith, to negotiate on that basis.

B.

The two Governments reaffirm that the principle of consent, as defined in the Downing Street Declaration, will be a guiding principle for them in the negotiations.
