

## PARADES

I have written to you separately about policy approval for the Parades Bill. Dr Mowlam also minuted the Prime Minister on 7 October about timing. The Prime Minister is content that you should surface the Bill, on the lines that you propose, next week. From various comments which David Trimble made to us yesterday, I would judge that he would prefer the longest possible gap between any announcement and his conference on 25 October. In other words, while he may be content for the news to come out in advance, he would not want it to come out just before the conference.
