UUP SHOPPING LIST

Jeffrey Donaldson has come back with the following shopping list:

- a) They want help with Mo on the Commission on victims. She is refusing to refer to those in the service of the crown. They have proposed saying "victims of violence, including those who died in the service of the crown/community". They have put this to David Hill and think he may accept. They are very keen that it is announced this week.
- b) They would like some progress on openness in the Anglo-Irish secretariat, but understand this will take some time.
- c) They would like the party funding legislation to apply to NI and include the ROI as a foreign country. I said we would be consulting on whether the legislation should apply to NI.
- d) They were not attracted by an interview with you in the Newsletter. It would look like an attempt to influence the Conference.
