for it to discharge its functions through committees formed in proportion to party strengths in the Assembly;

for Committee chairs etc to be allocated proportionally

to parties by the d'Hondt formula.

eg Policing;

the finances of an Asembly;

whether there should be any safeguards in addition to the incorporation of the European Convention on Human Rights.
