NORTHERN IRELAND: PROPOSED INVITATION TO PRESIDENT MANDELA

The Prime Minister was interested to see Dr Mowlam's minute of 12 December. He strongly supports the idea of such a visit, and is content with the proposed approach to Mandela by Dr Mowlam.
