NORTHERN IRELAND: HEADS OF AGREEMENT

A constitutional understanding, based on commitment to principle of consent by both British and Irish. Covernments, and including changes to Articles 2 and 3 of the Irish Constitution (the territorial claim).

A Northern Ireland Assembly, elected by a system of proportional representation. Devolution of executive and legislative responsibility over at least the responsibilities of the six Northern Ireland Departmento.

Replacement of the Anglo- Irish Agreement with a new British-Irish Agreement to establish closer cooperation and enhanced relationships, embracing: 3

A Council of these islands to deal with the totality of relationships, including the British and Irish Governments, the Northern Ireland administration, and Representatives of devolved institutions in the rest of the UK;

A Council for North/South co-operation, to bring together those with executive responsibilities in Northern Ireland and the Irish Government (Each) side to remain accountable to, and act within the mandate of the NI Assembly, and the Irish Parliament, respectively. All decisions to be by agreement between the two sides, North and South;

Standing Intergovernmental machinery (between the Trich and British governments) covering issues of mutual interest, including but not limited to Northern Traland.

Provisions to sufeguard the rights of both communities In Northern Ireland and address equality and justice 183466.
