In this connection they referred to the Anglo-Irish Agreement (AIA) and the Downing Street Declaration (DSD). Our initial response was that it might be possible to include the some of the language of Article 11(c) of the AIA, but we discouraged reference to the DSD. We do not want to have the "green" verbiage in the DSD in our law and we certainly want Her Majesty to have a clear unincumbered fee simple in Ulster and certainly not a determinable fee.
