- Violence from any quarter has no place in any of this. Heads of Agreement not prompted or influenced by Loyalist violence. No "orange" card.
- Would not be influenced by violence on the other side either. This cycle must be stopped. Condemn utterly all sectarian killing.
- Security authorities doing all they can to stop attacks. Have already made arrests.
- (UUP attitudes.) Hope Heads of Agreement will encourage better engagement by all parties. Cannot force them to speak to you bilaterally but encouraging them.
