The Prime Minister was grateful for Dr Mowlam's minute of 21 January, asking for policy clearance for a consultation paper on police/community links in Northern Ireland. The Prime Minister is content for this to be launched as proposed, as long as Dr Mowlam is confident that it is not likely to raise major alarms in either community at a delicate time, given the great sensitivity of policing issues in Northern Ireland. Are the main parties aware of what is coming? If not, would it be worth briefing them in advance to ensure they are not taken by surprise when the consultation paper is launched?
