ALLEGATIONS ABOUT MARTHA POPE

Further to John McKervill's minute of 5 December I thought I should explain my comments as reported in the Boston Globe on 4 December.

- 2. While I was in Boston the Martha Pope story was running strongly and I was told by the Consul General that Irish diplomats were briefing that it was a typical dirty tricks operation by MI5 designed to damage George Mitchell. When I went by previous arrangement to the Globe office on 3 December to give an off-the-record briefing I was immediately pressed about the story and Irish comments and decided that it would do no harm, and might do some good, if I corrected the Irish implications and put HMG's position on George Mitchell beyond doubt. If I had remained silent it would of course have had the reverse effect. Hence the Globe story, which is accurate in substance if not in every particular.
 - 3. I am glad now to see that others have been taking a similar line.
