MEETING WITH NIGEL WARNER, 11 JULY: PUS AND SIR DAVID FELL

PUS and Sir David Fell are meeting Nigel Warner, Mo Mowlam's adviser, on 11 July. The purpose of this meeting is to construct an agenda for a fuller meeting with the Shadow NI Team in the Autumn to discuss issues any incoming Labour government would need to be aware of in relation to Northern Ireland.

2. In order to prepare for the meeting with Nigel Warner, PUS and Sir David would like to have an annotated agenda detailing the key issues - in policy, legislation and organisational terms - which would need to be addressed urgently ie within three months of the new Parliament. Other ongoing business, eg the PES cycle, annual renewal of legislation should also be covered in the annotated agenda, looking ahead for one year.

3. I should be grateful if you would coordinate the production of the NIO's part of this annotated agenda. Central Secretariat will coordinate work on behalf of the NI Departments. I should be grateful if you would liaise with Central Secretariat to ensure that there is no duplication of effort on items such as PES, central initiatives, legislation etc.

4. I should be grateful for a response by 9 July.
