That way is the way of further delusion and deception. Ulster people are not prepared to accept you being duped a second time.

If you intend to bow the knee to Mark 11 of the Adams/Hume plan, then the DUP Members of Parliament will have no other option if and when occasions occur to seek to bring down your Government. I am sure you would expect from me plain and straight speech at this time that is why I feel it is my duty to write you this letter.
