- there is no reason for me or anyone else to reject this assurance, and I am happy to accept it.

- Dr Paisley has not shown me any such security report. It is well known that in any case it is not our policy to comment on security reports;
- I repeat what I have said before: I accept the Independent Chairman's assurance given in the talks that there has been no contact since his present appointment.
