

- Joint condemnation of violence. Aim is to wreck the talks: determined they will not succeed.
- Joint commitment to integrity of Mitchell principles. Want as many parties included as possible, but all must make a clear choice between democracy and violence.
- 3. Joint determination to press forward to agreement at Easter and referendum in May. Believe most parties and people want a deal: a fair deal for all is achievable.
- 4. Both Governments ready to play their part. Time soon coming for parties to negotiate on the overall deal, if agreement to be reached by Easter.
- 5. The parties must play their part. We can propose but we cannot impose.
