Mr. Hume, you've talked about the dialogue that you've had with members of Sinn Pein. A British newspaper on Sunday said that both Martin McGuinness and Gerry Adams were leading members of the IRA, what do you make of that?

Pinally, Mr. Hume, we spoke earlier about the forthcoming general election. There has been some speculation about whether or not you will be standing, do you intend to stand again?
