The Prime Minister was grateful for the Home Secretary's minute of 18 March. Subject to the comments of the Northern Ireland Secretary, he agrees that you should seek further assurances from the Irish Government about how they would operate the sentences of the five terrorist prisoners who have life sentences with whole life tariffs. We should look at the timing of future action in the light of the Irish reply.
