- Understand your feelings about our decision to publish, but no choice: conspiracy theories running riot.
- And could not have changed our position anyway.
- <u>Has</u> calmed position here enormously and improved prospects of progress in the talks on decommissioning.
- Want a ceasefire and inclusive talks. Much better.
- But cannot set a date for Sinn Fein entry. Depends on IRA/Sinn Fein words and actions.
- Have not moved goalposts: simply made clearer our understanding of paras 8 and 9 of Groundrules paper.
- If there is a ceasefire, will assess IRA/Sinn Fein's words and actions in all good faith.
- Do not want you to make unreasonable promises to Sinn Fein. Realise they do not trust us. But the only way forward is for them to declare a ceasefire and try us.

Decommissioning

Very keen to break through impasse before Christmas.
