VISIT OF SPLEEN - OUTLINE PROGRAMME (2)

- Following PUS's discussion this morning with Edward Oakden, I
 have drafted a further outline programme for the visit which is
 attached.
- 2. This programme includes Ballymena, (a courtesy call on the Mayor, plus carol singing with local children followed by a walk-about) lunch at St Patrick's Barracks, to include Chief Constable and GOC, followed by the official opening of the North City Business Centre, with a press opportunity at the Business Centre.
- 3. No 10 are still keen to include a meeting with the four Church Leaders acknowledging their helpful statement at the time of the Clinton Visit and to allow time for this, and for an estimated time of arrival from Aldergrove of 15.50, there would be not time left for Downpatrick, which therefore leaves the programme unbalanced in terms of local political parties. Indeed there is also very little time for a proper meeting with the Church

Leaders, nor is the Business Park an ideal location for this purpose. The Jet Centre at Aldergrove would be better, however this would eat into the timing even more. In relation to a meeting with the 4 Church Leaders, I understand that PUS has already conveyed the view that it may give the impression of tokenism and appear as a substitute for meetings with political leaders.

- 4. Edward also inquired about the possibility of a demonstration or protests in Ballymena. PAB take the view that the only protest would be from the DUP, and that the chances of this happening, while it can not be entirely discounted, are very low. The Party is rather demoralised at present, and the opportunity to portray Ballymena in a favourable light is likely to outweigh any organised protest.
- 5. To fly by helicopter directly to Dublin from Downpatrick would take 45/50 minutes by comparison with 20 minutes from Downpatrick to Aldergrove and 25 minutes by plane. There is therefore little saving (apart from transfer time) and the helicopter would be much more vulnerable to bad weather conditions, especially over the Mournes. As the attached programme demonstrates however, Downpatrick could only now be included as a substitute for North Belfast and the event would be similar to that in Ballymena.
