YOUR VISIT TO NORTHERN IRELAND: Thursday 21 December

We had a word on the flight back from Madrid. I have since spoken to Sir David Fell at the NIO. He was strongly in favour of your going ahead with the visit. He said that it had been quite some time since you were last in Northern Ireland. He thought it would be a particularly good idea for you to see the business community. And he felt that, if you were going to Dublin, it would be important to go first to the North.

I attach a revised programme, although I think it is still not quite right:

You would begin the programme in <u>Ballymena</u>, in Ian Paisley's constituency. He rang Edward today to ask if you would be coming. We should give him advance notice. NIO do <u>not</u> expect DUP demonstrations.

- The official opening of the North City Business Centre is a good idea. However, 25 minutes is surely too short a time for this. We should add a little, either by squeezing Ballymena or by taking off 10 minutes earlier.
- The <u>CBI\IOD Carol Service</u> at St. George's Church (which you attended a couple of years ago) would combine both Christmas and the business community. We agreed on the plane that this would be worth doing. I have suggested to NIO that you might read the lesson. **Content**?
- Downpatrick is an SDLP constituency (Eddie McGrady) to balance Ballymena. Having gone all the way there (15 minutes by helicopter) I think you might do a little more than just a walkabout. We could probably push departure for Dublin back a bit. Shall we ask NIO to add one other item, of business interest?

You would not give a <u>press conference</u>. We would deal with the media through photographs and doorsteps. The story for the day would be that this was (a) a Christmas visit; and (b) a look at the changing economy during the ceasefire.
