

OPERATION CHARITON - 18. your visit.

Thank you for your letter of 1 November about a possible Christmas Visit; of the two dates which you identified, Sir Patrick would prefer the later one, but of course is very happy to fit in with your diary.

You have also spoken to Sir John Chilcot about a school carol service, or other Christmas event being included. As CHARITON has attended the Northern Ireland Chamber of Commerce & Industry's Carol Service twice in the last three years, we feel that this would be best avoided on security grounds. So far we have been able to identify a school's cross-community carol service only on the earlier date (12 December), but we are still investigating and indeed, are reasonably confident that it should be possible to organise one when you are able to confirm the date.

We believe that the visit would also afford an opportunity to recognise some of the individuals and groups who have been painstakingly trying to rebuild cross-community relationships since the events of the summer, and this might be done over a buffet lunch. There is also the outstanding commitment to the Mayors of the twenty-six District Councils SECRET AND PERSONAL - VISITS

following the cancellation of their visit to London earlier in the year, and a Reception at Hillsborough for them (and perhaps their deputies and/or Economic Development spokesmen) could also provide a speech opportunity.

If your diary allowed, and CHARITON were able to stay until the evening (indeed overnight would be even better), a dinner party at Hillsborough could be arranged for some of the key individuals who are newly appointed such as Archbishop Brady (with other church leaders), the new Chief Constable and GOC; otherwise private meetings can be organised.

The attached list of options will, I hope, give you enough ideas from which a worthwhile programme can be created. When you have had an opportunity to consider this we would be happy to take forward your suggestions in the usual way.
