OPERATION CHARITON

Thank you for your letter of 13 September. We had a further word about this the other day. I also spoke to Sir John Chilcot in the margins of NI.

It is not easy to do much planning when the circumstances of any visit are so uncertain. But I believe the operation should go ahead before the end of the year if at all possible. We have identified two possible slots:

- Thursday 12 December, before the Dublin European Council the following day;
- Wednesday 18 December.

It would be helpful to have your views on these, and how they fit into the Christmas services point I mentioned to Sir John Chilcot. It would also be helpful to have a preliminary indication of what else might go into a programme at that time of year.
